The Cortez, CO, Fire Protection District has placed in service a mini pumper built by C.E.T. Mfg. via Pete's Equipment in Albuquerque, NM. It is built on a Ford F-550 4 x 4 with a diesel engine. It has a 400-gallon water tank with a 10-gallon foam cell, a C.E.T. Mfg. PFP 25-hp DSL-MR fire pump powered by a Kubota engine with a direct connect to the main fuel tank, a Scotty around-the-pump foam system, a preconnected electric rewind hose reel with rollers and booster hose, and Whelen warning lights.

E-ONE

The Lebanon, IN, Fire Department has taken delivery of an E-ONE Metro 100-foot quint. The Cyclone chassis features an aluminum cab with split raised roof and seating for four, and is powered by a Cummins 450-hp ISL9 engine. The



extruded aluminum body has a SideStacker hosebed and storage for 156 feet of ground ladders. With a wheelbase of only 235 inches and a short rear overhang, this rig provides impressive maneuverability. The fire package includes a 1,500-gpm Hale DSD pump and a 500-gallon UPF Poly III water tank. The 100-foot aerial features a 2.5:1 structural safety factor and crisscross under-slung outriggers with an 11-foot jack spread.

The Garfield, NJ, Fire Department took delivery of a Ferrara MVP rescue pumper built on an Igniter custom chassis featuring an 8-inch raised roof cab with seating for seven and tool-mounting boards. It is powered by a Cummins ISL9 450-hp engine and an Allison 3000 EVS transmission. The extruded aluminum MVP rescue body houses a Hale QMAX 2,000-gpm pump, TFT Hurricane deck gun, 750-gallon water tank, chainsaw storage module, ladder storage, booster reel, rooftop compartments and substantial space for rescue equipment. It also has a Will-Burt light tower and a Harrison 10,000-watt hydraulic generator.

The Kewanee, IL, Fire Department has taken delivery of an all-new custom HME Ahrens-Fox

rescue pumper, built on an HME 1871 W custom chassis, with aluminum wheels. The truck is powered by a Cummins ISL 9 370-hp engine with an Allison 3000EVS transmission. The truck also features a 320-amp Leece Neville alternator, LED strip-light interior light packages and LED compartment packages, a cab roof-mounted Whelen Freedom 72-inch light bar system, and front left and right 20,000 lumens quartz flood lighting. The stainless-steel body has 221 cubic feet of compartment storage with adjustable shelving throughout, and 72 cubic feet of hosebed space available, all placed on a painted double-frame rail chassis. It also has a Hale 1,250-gpm Q-Flo Plus pump and a UPF 794-gallon tank.

The pumper body is constructed of 3/16-inch aluminum, featuring full-depth and split-height compartments, a low hosebed and Lock-N-Load hosebed cover.






U.S. Tanker
